

TE ATATU PONY CLUB GRAZING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Application for grazing must be in writing and handed into committee members on Enrolment Day. All applications are to be discussed and approved at the Executive level who will decide whether or not to accept your application based on the following;

- 80% of committee meetings attended by family
- 80% of available rallies attended by rider
- working bee obligation fulfilled

Should your application for grazing be declined, Te Atatu Pony Club will allow you one calendar month for you to find suitable grazing.

Grazing Fees are currently \$110 per month.

By applying for Grazing you agree to the following conditions;

1. Horses must be checked a minimum of four times a week.
2. All grazers must notify a Grazing Team Member when the horse will be removed overnight or longer. Please fill in a Horse Movement Form, this can be found on the Grazing Board.
3. All grazers must be financial members however this is not an acceptance of grazing rights.
4. The "GROUNDS CLOSED" sign is to be adhered to at all times. We ask that you exercise your discretion when using the grounds and that you refrain from driving vehicles, jumping horses, lunging and or riding in general when conditions are adverse due to weather.
5. No person may interfere with any other grazers' horse/s on Club grounds except with permission of the owner, but are expected to contact a member of the grazing team and owner if a horse/pony is injured or distressed.
6. All horses grazing on Club grounds are to be tested for fecal egg counts (FEC) and worms as per the schedule and drenched when deemed necessary by the Grazing Team, with a drench suggested by the vet. The drench will be at the cost of the member while FEC will be covered by grazing fees.
7. Grazing fees of \$110 are to be paid on the 1st of every month.
8. Grazer's horses must be placed where the Grazing Team deems fit.
9. Grazers must be available to move their horses when requested. Grazers are not allowed to change paddocks, or put up pens, at their own discretion.
10. Grazers are to check and clean the water troughs on a regular basis (see roster) and report immediately any damaged fences, troughs or other equipment to a committee member.
11. In cases of emergency a vet may be summoned by a member of the Grazing Team. These costs are the sole responsibility of the grazer. All grazers must have a contact telephone number visible and available to each pony club grazer.
12. The health and wellbeing of horses/ponies is the owners' responsibility.
13. The costs associated with damage to or death of a horse/pony is the owner's responsibility. While the club is not liable, the Executive Team has discretionary rights to assist in cases of hardship. This will be considered on a case by case basis.

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14. It is a privilege to graze on Pony Club grounds and it is in the best interest of all grazers that each and every one of you ensures the safety and welfare of all horses grazing. If there is a problem at any time DO NOT hesitate to contact a member of the Grazing Team or any other committee member.
15. The removal of dung shall be done as and when requested.
16. Horses under four years of age, stallions, rigs or mares with foals or in foal may not be grazed on Pony Club grounds.
17. Any horse deemed to be extremely troublesome or a danger to other grazers, horses or people will be removed with instant termination of grazer's rights.
18. Horses must be penned or moved to the allocated paddock on Rally nights. (Grazing Team to co-ordinate with Rally Team).
19. Support, friendliness and respect for other members are expected at all times. Negative unfriendly and anti social behaviour will not be tolerated. All members must abide by the NZPCA Code of Conduct.
20. Adult members (26 years and over) may have access to grazing if available or as Club Committee sees fit. An Adult Grazing Contract must be signed.
21. There will be a maximum of one horse or pony per child riding member allowed. Any variance to this may be at the discretion of the Executive Team and the Grazing Coordinator.
22. Winter grazers will be required to pay for hay during the winter months.
